

## Notes for the booking of groups for a tour of the galleries:

Persons making group bookings are obliged to point out the following safety regulations to all members of their group:

### Safety regulations for the gallery facilities at the Stephansberg in Bamberg (July 2023)

The long history of the galleries means there are uneven surfaces, dampness, uneven steps, limited lighting, in parts low tunnel roofs and so on, so that a residual risk (e.g. stumbling, twisting one's ankle, bumping into something) cannot be ruled out. Insofar the City of Bamberg does not take legal responsibility. Entrance is therefore always at one's own risk.

- Each person must bring a flashlight.
- Wearing a helmet in the galleries is compulsory. We recommend urgently that adults and children bring a bicycle or climbing helmet.
- Good tough shoes are an urgent necessity. Moving away from the group or entering closed galleries is forbidden. Closed galleries have considerable hidden dangers!
- The guide's instruction must be followed.
- The guide must be informed immediately of any accident or injury.
- Children are allowed entry at the age of eight years upwards and then only in the company of adults. This does not release adults from their legal responsibility.
- Persons with health restrictions and persons with a handicap must observe the "Health Requirements" below.
- Smoking and alcohol are forbidden in the galleries. Persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs are not allowed to entry.
- The consumption of food and drinks is not allowed during the tour.
- It is not allowed to take animals with you.

**The City of Bamberg does not take on any legal liability for any damage caused by deliberate or negligent violations of the safety regulations.**

### Health Requirements:

Due to particular climatic and technical conditions in the galleries (e.g. temperature fluctuations, not free of hindrance) the galleries are **not suitable** for the following people:

- Persons who must avoid an increased strain on heart, circulation, breathing.
- Persons with a proneness to epileptic attacks.
- Pregnant women from the fifth month of pregnancy.
- Persons with claustrophobia or a fear of the dark.
- Persons with immunodeficiency.

Persons with other special health characteristics or handicaps are advised to enquire in the VHS as to whether a visit to the galleries is possible.

Persons who need to take a certain **medicine** (e.g. diabetes medication) should bring it with them and inform the guide as a precaution for emergencies.

**The following rules apply:**

- The number of participants is restricted to 20 persons.
- Tunnel visitors have to disinfect their hands before entering.

Visitors with corona-specific signs of disease (fever, dry coughing, respiratory problems, loss of sense of smell and taste, limb pain, nausea, diarrhoea) are not allowed to enter the tunnels.
